

Re: European RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU

RoHS legislation compliance first became a legal requirement on 1st July 2006.

The RoHS2 directive came into effect in July 2011

The latest directive under RoHS2 (2015/863) came into effect on 4th June 2015 adding 4 phthalates to the list of banned substances. The list of substances and limits is now as follows:

Cadmium(Cd): 0.01%

Mercury: 0.1%

Lead(Pb) : 0.1%

Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+) : 0.1%

Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB): 0.1 %;

Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE): 0.1 %

Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): 0.1% (added in 2015);

Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): 0.1% (added in 2015);

Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): 0.1% (added in 2015);

Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): 0.1% (added in 2015).

We have the necessary assurances from our suppliers that all of the components we use contain less than the specified limits of banned substances.
